 - Students in Grades 9 & 10 will be combined together in a large group at each session. During most class, students also will gather together with their small group to creatively process the material given during the lesson.
 - Faith Formation sessions have a dynamic that combines large group activities and presentations with small group interaction and “hands on” work.

Expectations of Students

- CELL PHONE USE IS **NOT** ALLOWED IN CLASS. IF THEY ARE USED THEY WILL BE TAKEN AWAY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE CLASS. IF THERE ARE REPEATED OFFENSES, PARENTS/ GUARDIANS WILL NEED TO PICK UP THE CELL PHONE FOR THE STUDENTS.
- Students are expected to respect each other, their facilitators, and anyone who is speaking or sharing.
- Respect all opinions and ideas.
- Students are expected to attend all classes. A student needs to attend at least one full year of high school Faith Formation to be eligible to enroll in Confirmation preparation. If a student is absent from a significant number of classes (more than three), he or she will not be eligible to enroll in Confirmation preparation.
- **Come to class on time.** Repeated late arrivals will count as absences. Once students are here, they need to stay for the entire class time. If a student needs to leave early, he/ she must bring a note from a parent and the parent must come into the Main Hall to pick up the student.
- Because of the interactive nature of the sessions, we are not able to send material home to make up for missed sessions.
- Participate actively in all activities. This will include times of quiet reflection and prayer.
- Follow the directions of the facilitators and the coordinator.
- Bring a Bible to every class session, we use them often.
